



**BY THE KING  
A DECREE  
JOSEPH R.**

**WHEREAS** it is the desire of Our Royal and Apostolic Majesty to cease the acceptance of any applications for citizenship of the Kingdom of Natal; and

**WHEREAS** We do however believe that it would be beneficial for foreign nationals with an expressed interest in the Realm to contribute to the growth and development of the Kingdom, or to otherwise appreciate the concepts which Natal has represented since her independence;

**KNOW YE THAT WE** do hereby establish the honorary citizenship of the Kingdom of Natal, a status to be granted to applicant individuals by Our Royal and Apostolic Majesty through letters patent; and

**FURTHERMORE,** We do hereby charge the Chancery Office for Foreign and Imperial Affairs to receive and process applications for honorary citizenship which shall be submitted to Our Royal and Apostolic Majesty for review following the approval of the Secretary of the Chancery for Foreign and Imperial Affairs.
